# Proposed Amendments to KFCO CBL 2017 Passed

Kalayaan Filipino Cultural Organization (KFCO) held its annual general membership meeting last 29 Oct. 2017 at the KCCC Me-Room. Rodel dia Meier, KFCO Chairman, made the welcoming speech acknowledging and thanking the support provided by the various associations and groups as well as from the past chairs of the

Organization. The major activities handled / participated by KFCO were reported. While Josie Salac, Treasurer. briefed the audience financial status as of the end of Sept. 2017 fiscal year. Rodel M. mentioned that "KFCO was a team that relied on each other, covered for each other without hesitation".

One of the highlights of the meeting was the referendum on the proposed amendments to KFCO's Constitution and By-Laws (CBL). The process to think about the changes to be put in place for KFCO's CBL started way back in 2011 and was continued on by the various officers of the Organization thereon with the integration of feedback mechanism from its members. Through the raising of hands, with an affirmation of 38 YES votes, the numbers obtained is well within the 2/3 of those present in the meeting to ratify the proposed amendments.

# Senator Tobias 'Jun' Enverga, Jr., a tribute December 2, 1955 – November 16, 2017 (62)



#### Mga Kababayan,

I wish to convey our heartfelt condolence to the family of Senator Jun Enverga; namely, his wife Rosemer and their 3 children; Rystle, Reeza and Rocel. The Filipino Community in Canada is deeply devastated and saddened at his untimely demise while attending the 14<sup>th</sup> Plenary Assembly of ParlAmericas, the institution that promotes parliamentary diplomacy in the inter-American system, in Medellin, Colombia. The conference was scheduled on November 15-17, Senator Enverga, Jr., representing Canada, died on the 16<sup>th</sup>.

Since his appointment to the Senate of Canada or what we described as *sober second thought upper chamber*, on September 6, 2012, many observed that the Pinoy Senator had been burning his candle at both ends. Aside from attending to his normal duties as senator, he was everywhere; at various festivities of Filipino organizations, birthdays, or even funerals in Toronto or in Mississauga, particularly.

Our interactions with the then mere Jun Enverga were during the years when he was the president of PIDC (Philippine Independence Day Council, 2006 - 2009) of Toronto, the equivalent of Kalayaan Filipino Cultural Organization in Peel Region. The two organizations are devoted to celebrating the Philippine Independence and promoting the Philippine culture in Canada.

While always approachable when he was representing PIDC, he became much closer to the whole Filipino Community when he became Canada's only Filipino senator; remaining very humble and very friendly.

Understandably, the pain of losing a husband to Rosemer and a father to his 3 children was beyond words but his demise is equally felt by the Filipino Community he represented so well, with full dedication and commitment.

According to Statistics Canada, there are at least 662,600 Filipinos in Canada; 275,380 (or 41.6 %)



are residing in Ontario; thus, we represent approximately 2% of total population of Ontario and Canada respectively. At the Federal Level, we have 334 Members of the Parliament. At 2%, there should have at least 6 Filipino MPs, instead, we have ZERO. None!

At the Senate, we should have at least 2 senators out of the 105. Instead, we have 1 when Prime Minister appointed Senator Tobias Enverga, Jr. on September 6, 2012. And now, the Senator is gone.

But this is the time to celebrate the senator's life and contributions to the Filipino Community. This is the time to express our gratitude for his service.

**Thank you, Jun! Thank you, Senator.** May your family find peace in knowing that you have done more than your share. May your soul rest in peace. Until we meet again!
