Minutes of Annual General Meeting November 20, 2022 #3-5225 Orbitor Drive, Mississauga, ON L4W 5M6

- 1. Call to order @ 3:09 PM
 - 1.1. Attendance: Quorum has been reached. There's a total of 32 attendees that included representatives from the following groups: Filipino Seniors; Hula; Bayanihan; KCCC & KFCO.
 - 1.2. Agenda accepted by Lourdes Lachica; Seconded by Rene Sevilla
 - 1.3. The history of KFCO was briefly summarized by Rene and hard copies were distributed to all attendees.
 - 1.4. Minutes of 2019 AGM was reviewed by all. Acceptance motioned by Rodel Meier, seconded by Fe Tabago

2. Chairman's Report:

- 2.1 Code of Conduct, including the confidentiality clause, was created as part of the requirement on the supplemental guideline set by city of Mississauga. A copy can be provided to KFCO members upon request.
- 2.2 Independence Day Gala held on June 10, 2022 at the Mississauga Grand was a big success albeit the size of the room was limited to only 120 guests.
- 2.3 Independence Day Picnic held on June 18, 2022 at Mississauga Valley Park went very well.
- 2.4 Philippine Festival held on July 16 & 17 2022 at the Mississauga Celebration Square drew more audience / attendance compared to pre-pandemic events.
- 2.5 On July 19, 2021, KFCO board discussed and agreed to propose a possible merger between KFCO & KCCC. Letter of Intent addressed to KCCC dated August 4, 2021, was read during this AGM meeting as well as KCCC's response of unanimously accepting the aforesaid proposal.
- 3. Treasurer's Report presented by Fe Tabago, Treasurer and Josie Salac, Auditor of KFCO.
- 3.1 Copies of Financial Report for year ended September 30, 2022 were distributed and a quick summary entailed:

4.3 Referendum Voting:

- Members were asked if they a) are in favor of the proposed merger and b) authorize KFCO to continue talks with KCCC in this regard.
- One of the members had asked the pros of the merge and KCCC chairperson Resty del Rosario had explained that since KCCC has high reputation with the city of Mississauga, same with KFCO, the merger will:
- Result to harmonized planning of activities in terms of notification and registration
- Have big impact to the community
- Result to KCCC being able to claim GST rebate

4.4 Tallying of Votes:

Referendum: 25 members overwhelmingly voted $\bf YES$ to possible KFCO & KCCC merger vs. 2 that voted $\bf NO$ and 5 in abstention.
